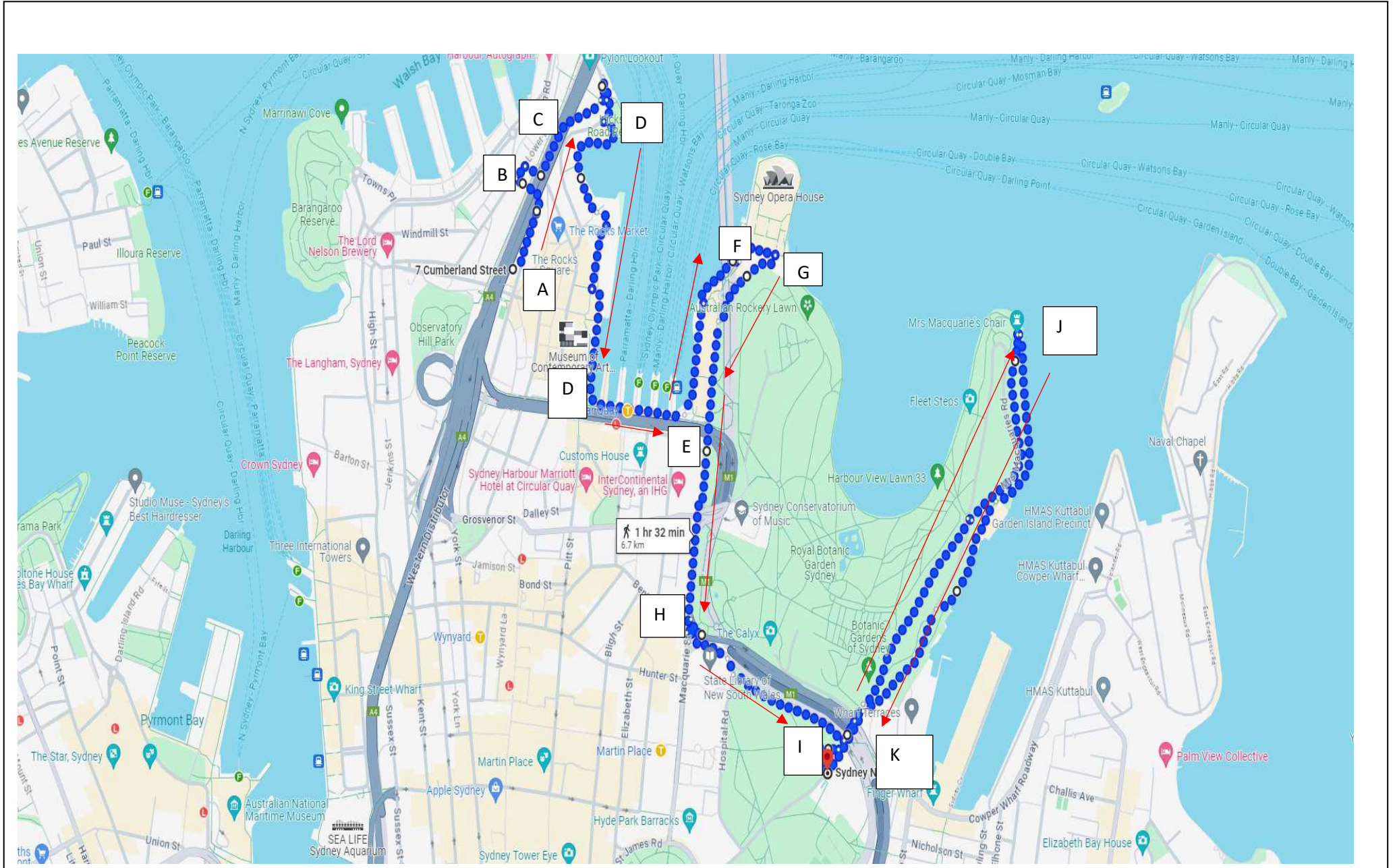


SYDNEY ROUTE – DAY 1. Sunday 16th June -Depart 8am – at 100 Cumberland Street The Rocks (Outside Australian Hotel)

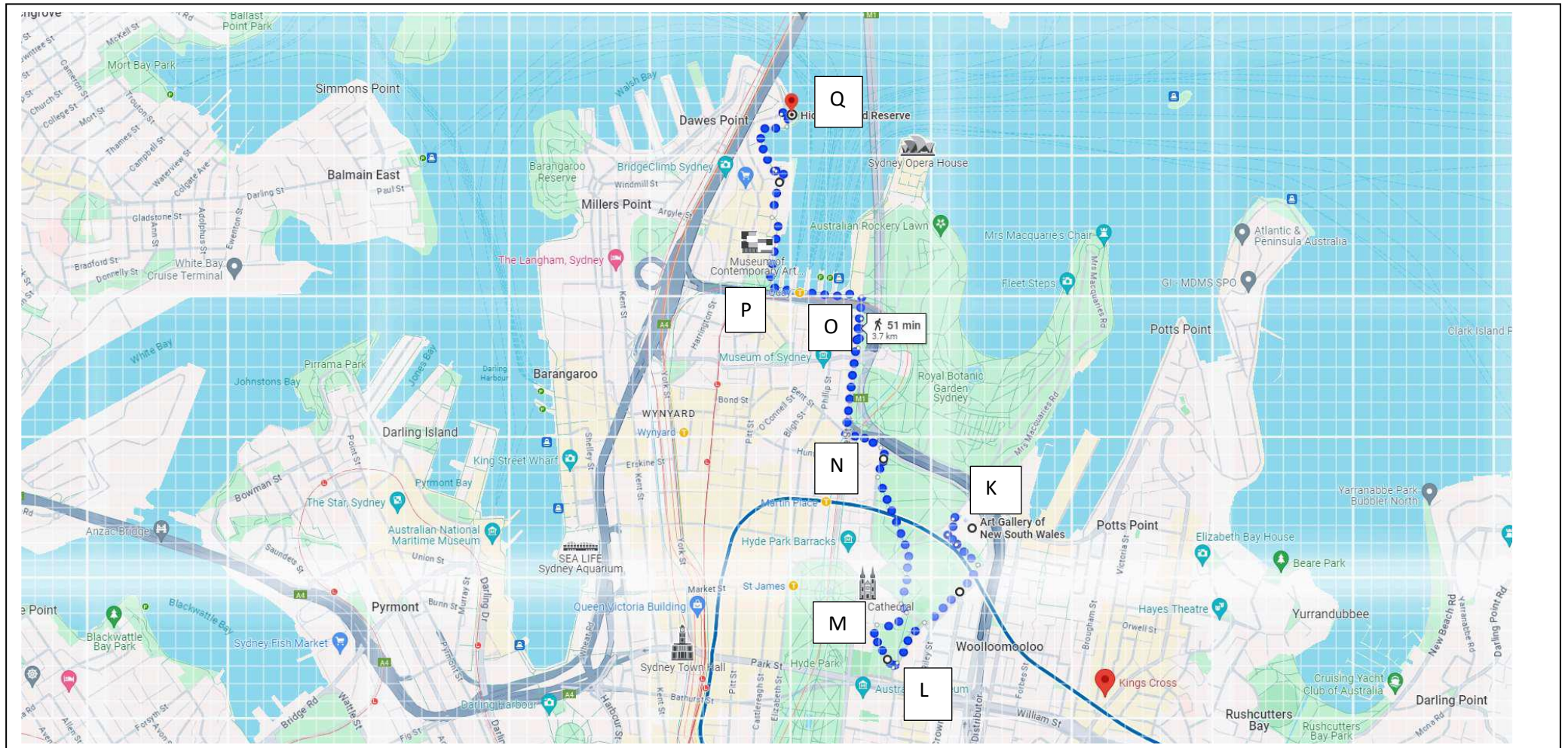
THE CHARITY RUN STARTS 8AM SHARP

MAP 1. (see instructions A to K)



- A. 7.30am to 8am Start at 100 Cumberland Street , The Rocks (Outside The Australia Hotel) Opposite the Steps onto the Sydney harbour Bridge
- NOTE :** The Vivid Light Festival will be concluding on the Harbor foreshores on Saturday night 15th June. Please comply with Police directions during the pack-up on the Sunday morning..
- B. Runners - Run North down Cumberland Street towards Harbor Bridge where Cumberland Street veers left underneath the Harbor Bridge and turn sharp Right onto Lower Fort Street and immediately turn under the bridge on George Street and turn left at the pedestrian crossing (underneath bridge)
- C. At the Pedestrian Crossing (underneath bridge) run towards Bridge Pylons and veer to the right and run down to the Harbor foreshore and follow the pedestrian pathway on the harbor running past The Hyatt Hotel (opposite The Opera House) , past mooring of the famous Bounty sailing ship The International Cruising Ship Terminal and follow the pedestrian walkway all the way to Circular Quay.
- D. Turn left at Circular Quay and run past all 6 Harbour Ferry Wharfs (opposite Circular Quay Railway on the right)
- E. Turn Left and run approx. 400 metres north towards the Opera House entrance and proceed to the steps opposite of the Opera House .
- F. **SYDNEY OPERA HOUSE – PHOTO OPPORTUNITY) Maximum 10 minutes .**
- G. Proceed to the rock way opposite the Opera House Steps and run up the stairs towards Tarpeian Way – past Bennelong Lawns (opposite Governor’s Residence) proceed running on the footpath south along Macquarie Street until you cross the Intersection opposite The State Mitchell Library. **DO NOT ENTER THE BOTANICAL GARDENS** (We couldn’t get permission to enter the Gardens) Please comply with Traffic Signals as you cross Sir John Young Crescent
- H. Turn left at the State Library and follow the walkway into The Domain Parkway and proceed until you arrive opposite The NSW State Art Gallery.
- I. Turn left opposite the NSW Art Gallery and run north towards Sydney Harbor following Mrs Macquarie Drive on the edge of Sydney Botanical Gardens until you arrive at Mrs Macquarie Chair. You will find the historic rock seat that was carved out by the early convicts in the late 1700’s for Governor Lachlan Macquarie’s wife for her pleasure as she enjoyed the prime view overlooking Sydney Harbor.
- J. Proceed up Mrs Macquarie Drive (along the foreshore) until you arrive at The Art Gallery of NSW.

MAP 2 (See instructions K to Q)



- K. The State Art Gallery of NSW.
- L. Proceed running down behind the NSW Art Gallery (The Domain Park) until you see the Giant Match Sticks Sculpture overlooking Sir John Young's Road. Run along the bottom edge of the Domain until you arrive at St Mary's Road. Run up St Mary's Road until you arrive at The Registrar General's Office.
- M. The Old Sydney Mint opposite St Mary's Cathedral and Sydney's Supreme Court Building on Macquarie Street. Proceed in the Domain Gardens behind the Mint and follow the walkways until you arrive at the rear of The Mitchell State Library.

- N. At the Mitchell State Library cross over the pedestrian crossing at Sir John Young Crescent and proceed to run north down the walkway along Macquarie Street until you arrive at Circular Quay overpass.
- O. Carefully cross Macquarie Street and proceed to Circular Quay and run through the Circular Quay (opposite the wharfs) until you arrive in the park adjacent to Circular Quay.
- P. Turn right and run north past the International Cruising Ship Terminal and follow the walkway on the harbor front past the historic Bounty sailing boat past the International Hyatt Hotel until you arrive at Hickson Place.
- Q. **Hickson Reserve Park (Hickson Road, The Rocks)** – this very small park is located immediately opposite the southern Harbor Bridge pylon. We must return to this point by 10am to ensure that we can proceed on time to arrive at Goulburn by 2pm.
